Master Stage Structure

Units 1 & 2

- Formative
- · Create foundational knowledge of the subject
- Exposes students to the type of assessment for Units 3 & 4
- Recorded as satisfactory or unsatisfactory
- Reported to parents on A-E scale

Units 3 & 4

- Summative
- 4 assessment items
- · General Subjects = 3 Internal + 1 External
- Applied Subjects = 4 Internal
- · Assessments have varied weightings (see below)
- · Must achieve a C or higher to achieve OCF points
